Forecasts about the increase in value (purchasing power) of Dhana

Dhana (www.dhana.org) is the worldwide currency of the Republic of the Earth (www.asmad.org). Dhana is the only currency with real value, as it is guaranteed since the issue by equity capitals for a nominal value equal to one gram of fine platinum (XTP) per one Dhana (currently 1 Dhana = 37 US Dollars).

The Dhura body (www.dhura.org), founded by the Republic of the Earth, issues Dhana and controls its monetary system.

Dhana has been issued to start the equitable redistribution of wealth, which now is concentrated in few hands.

Dhana is in physical, electronic (www.gandhana.org) and telematic currency (www.akadhana.org).

Dhana is divided into one thousand Kana-Dhana. Dhana in tickets is in 1, 5, 10, 50, 100 Dhana and in 1, 5, 10, 25, 50, 100 and 500 Kana-Dhana denominations.

Each inhabitant of the planet aged at least sixteen years old is assigned 100 Dhana (current value equal to 3700 US Dollars) against the only reimbursement of the issuing cost, different for each Country proportionally to the average per-capita yield, or against the commitment to perform 100 hours of work within five years from the date of assignation.

According the Statute of Dhana, not more than 100 Dhana per each recipient (about 5 billion people) can't be issued, plus 5% to be addressed to humanitarian initiatives (for which a special 1000 Dhana-ticket has been issued).

Therefore, the issue of a maximum of about 500 billion Dhana to be assigned and 25 billion Dhana for humanitarian initiatives is planned.

The maximum issue limit causes a constant increase in value of Dhana, i.e. of its purchasing power.

Such an increase can be from 54 to 80 times the current value, through both the diffusion of Dhana and the devaluation of legal tender money.

Essentially, the (long-term) future value can be equal to at least 54 grams of fine platinum per one Dhana (about 2000 US Dollars per 1 Dhana) but, probably it will reach a value of 80 grams of fine platinum per one Dhana (about 3000 US Dollars per one Dhana).

Consequently, the equivalent value of 100 Dhana in the short-term future can be from 200000 to 300000 US Dollars.

Afterwards the value of Dhana will increase proportionally to the trade volume of real economy.
